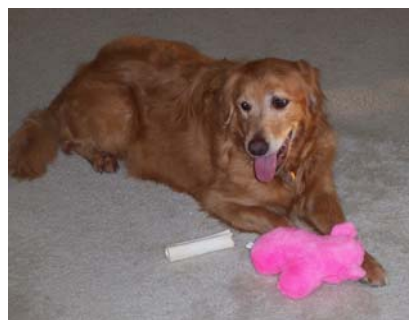
MADDY SERVING HER COUNTRY
