Happy Endings

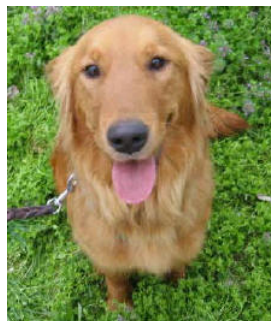
